

1.INTRODUCTION:

Namakkal District is an important district in Tamil Nadu of cultural and industrial importance. The district is endowed with the strengths of infrastructure, structure and super structure. The dint of sheer climatic conditions, the natural resources and the workforces for trade and service portfolios for agriculture and the industries have offered a better potential for export. Based on the vision of Honourable Chief Minister of Tamilnadu steps are to be taken to transform every district into export hubs. Creation of export hubs will raise the living standard of the local residents, ensure meaningful employment and ensure a healthy restriction on outflow of labours from their native to the big cities.

2.DISTRICT PROFILE:

Namakkal District is a newly formed district from Salem District. It is functioning from 01-01-1997. The district is bounded by salem on the north, Karur on the south, Trichy and Salem on the east and Erode on the West. The Geographical area of the district is 3368.21 Sq.Kms. Which lies between 11.00 and

11.360 North Latitude and 77.280 and 78.300 East Longitude. The district is bounded by Salem district on the north; on the east by, Tiruchirapalli District, by Karur District on the south and on the west by Erode district.

2.1 ADMINISTRATIVE PROFILE:

For Administrative purposes the district has been divided into 2 Revenue Divisions, 8 Taluks, 30 Revenue firkas. For local arrangements, the district has been divided into 5 Municipalities, 15 Panchayats Unions, 19 Town Panchayats and 322 Village Panchayats




2.2 DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE:

Population:

As per the 2011 census, the total population of the Namakkal district ha 17.26 lakhs. The rural population was high (59.68%) as compared to the urban population which accounted for 40.32 percent. The male population (51%) was marginally higher than the female population (49%). The male and female literates had constituted 55 per cent and 45 percent of the population respectively. 2.3 CLIMATE AND RAINFALL:

The climate had tropical in Namakkal. In winter, there had much less rainfall than in summer. This climate had considered to be average according to the Koppen-Geiger climate classification. The average temperature in Namakkal had 28.3°C. The average annual rainfall had 716.54mm.



2.4 TOURISM:

NAMAKKAL FORT:

The Namakkal Fort is a historic fort famous in Namakkal District in unique in South India. The fort was built during the reign of Thirumalai Nayak of Madurai in 17 Century. The fort is located on the top of a hillock made of a single rock, 75m (246ft) tall.

ANJANEYAR TEMPLE:

The Namakkal Anjaneyar Temple is located in Namakkal and dedicated to the Hindu god Hanuman. It was constructed in the Dravidia style of architecture. The legend of the temple is associated with Narasimha avatar of Hindu god Vishnu appearing for Hanuman and Lakshman. The image of Anjaneyar is 18ft (5.5m) tall, making it one of the tallest images of Hanuman in India.

AGAYA GANGAI WATERFALLS:

An Agaya Gangai waterfall is located in Kolli Hills of the Eastern Ghats, in India , Panchanathi, a jungle stream,

cascades down as the Agayagangai (English: Ganges of Sky), near Arapaleeswarar temple a top the Kolli Hills It is a 300feet (91m) waterfall of the river Aiyaru.


2.6 INFRASTRUCTURE:

ELECTRICITY:



In Namakkal District the power consumption for the Industry had 41.43% as against the National average of 36.7%. For agriculture, it had 23.45 percent against the national average of 21 percent.

The commercial consumption had 5.28 percent while the National average had 15.2 percent. In terms of analysis of taluk wise consumption of energy for various purposes like agriculture, industry institution, trade and commerce and public, it is evident that all Categories of consumption had at high levels in Namakkal taluk among the industry Tiruchengode stands first.

The road facilities had well thought- out as artillery of economy. The availability and quality of road is an important determinant factor for the fast flow of movement of goods and services from the place of origin to the point of burning up. The availability of the roads in the district has & analyzed here.

The road transport facility of Namakkal District has excellent the National highways from Kashmir to Kanyakumari pass through this district for a length nearly 50 km from the Salem to

Karur district. The road connects to Salem. In North up to Bangalore and to Northern States, Trichy in Eastern side up to Thanjavur and Nagapattinam, Karur in southern side up to Madurai and Kanyakumari and Erode in western side up to Coimbatore, Mysore in Karnataka state and Cochin in Kerala State. The Bus facilities are enormous for all the directions to connect important places of the state from Namakkal. The corporation bus service covers all the important towns, places of pilgrimage and other tourist places.

The accessibility of train facility has provided recently in Namakkal which connects to Salem, from where it connects to all the Northern places in India and its other side had connected to Karur for reaching all places of southern side of the state. Namakkal is also called as transport city because it has more number of lorries, tanker, trailers and trucks which operates through-out India. In terms of air transport, the facility can be availed only by travel up to 80km from Namakkal to Trichirappalli which is an International airport. To reach the nearest domestic airport Salem, it needs to travel around 55 km by road.

3.POLICY FRAMEWORK:


The state export promotion committee meeting was held on 17.3.2020. The following were discussed to transform the district of Namakkal into an export hub.

- To create a special wing to focus on export promotion of the district.
- To address the issues of various industries of the district.
- To list the potential export products of the district.
- To obtain necessary certification and upgrade the skill of pepper growers in the Kolli hills region and initiate export of the same.
- Identify the bottleneck hindering export in the district
- To prepare a dynamic export promotion plan to promote export from the district.

4.AGRICULTURAL PROFILE:


The agriculture is the main activity in Namakkal and the major crops grown here are paddy, groundnut, tapioca, sugarcane, turmeric, banana, maize green gram, sorghum & minor millets.

5.HORTICULTURE PROFILE:


The major horticulture crop in the district has banana (Mohanur and Namagiripet blocks), Mango (Sendhamangalam block), Tomato & Turmeric (Namagiripet block), Jack fruit, Pineapple & Coffee in Kollihills and betelleaf on the sides of river Cauvery through the blocks of Paramathi Velur, Kabilarmalai and Mohanur Vegetable like Tomato, Onion, Brinjal, Ladies finger, Potato, Yam had also grown in the district in smaller area. A banana ripening chamber of 50MT capacity had also been commissioned by the Government of Tamil Nadu in Mohanur block.



6.SERICULTURE PROFILE:

According to the statistics, the farmers of Namagiripet, Vennandur, Mallasamuthiram and Kabilarmalai actively

involved in sericulture farming activity, Compared with the last year report Vennandur block was slipped to. 2- place from the top and Tiruchengode had slipped to 4* place from 3" place.

7.1 INDUSTRIAL CLUSTER:

1. Textile and Powerloom cluster: Tiruchengode, Kumaraplalayan and Pallipalayan are identified as textile cluster. The cluster contribute in supplying fabric for woven products and home textile products.

2. Poultry Cluster: Namakkal is the the leading producer of eggs. Thus the region is a popular cluster for poultry.

3.Coir Cluster: Parmathi, Velur, and Mohanur are identified as Coir Cluster area.

7.2 NOTABLE INDUSTRIES:

Poultry Industry: Namakkal is the major producer of Egg in Southern Region. Hence, called as Egg City. About 80% of the layer farms in Tamilnadu are concentrated in and around Namakkal. By dedicated hard work and entrepreneurship the poultry farmers have successfully established large poultry packets in this region and Namakkal has come to be known as Poultry City.



The export of eggs and egg powder is highest from Tamil Nadu. Almost 95% of the export of shell eggs from India is from this state. More than 1,000 million eggs are exported, mostly to Afro-Asian countries, from India, of which 95% comes from Namakkal.

Lorry Building Industry: This is a unique feature of the district. More than 150 Lorry body building workshops and with a number of subsidiary industries of auto body works are operating since 1960's. There are Lorries, Trailers and L.P.G. Tanker Lorries in Namakkal district. Therefore it is called as "Transport City". Nearly 25000 people are employed either directly or indirectly in truck body building activity and about 300 units in Namakkal and 100 Units in Tiruchengode are engaged in this activity.

Weaving and Powerloom Industry: The chief industry of Rasipuram town is weaving. Puttunoolkarar who belongs in Sourashtra Community lives in large numbers in this town together with kaikolar. They are weaving Cotton Cloth and silk Saris. Kumarapalayam is a popular textile town of the district. Nearly 37 spinning mills and more than 10.000 Power looms are functioning in this area.

Sago Industries: Nearly 176 Sago factories are located in and around the Namakkal and Rasipuram Taluk. Sago and Starch production in this area are exported to other countries.

8.LIST OF POTENTIAL EXPORT PRODUCTS:

8.1 POULTRY PRODUCTS:

Namakkal is the leading producer of poultry products in Tamil Nadu. The poultry production in Namakkal region has grown in leaps and bounds and has attained the status of an organised industry. As a result, the poultry industry in Tamil Nadu is the most dynamic segment of the livestock sector. The strength of layer birds in the Namakkal zone in 2011 stood at 45 million, and the production of eggs had reached an average of 300 eggs per bird. At present, the Namakkal zone of the National Egg Coordination committee accounts for about 1,100 poultry farmers who own more than 45-million-layer birds. On average, 3.5 crore (30.50 million) eggs per day are produced in Namakkal zone of which 50 lakhs (5 million) is for consumption in Tamil Nadu. The remainder is supplied to the neighboring states of Kerala and Karnataka as well as north Indian state. India is the fifth largest producer of eggs and ninth largest producer of poultry meat amongst all the countries. Tamil Nadu is at the forefront of poultry production in the country, with a poultry population of about 11.73 crore (11.73 million). Automation is the order of the day and newer technologies such as computerized and automated feeding, automated watering and automated egg collection are being adopted. Tamil Nadu

witnessed cumulative growth of 23.5% in egg production and 30.53% in poultry meat production during 2013-14 to 2017-18. Tamil Nadu has India's second-highest layer population after Andhra Pradesh's (at 44 million), and now produces 10.8 billion eggs. Exports too are taking off. Table egg exports from Namakkal started 25 years ago in a small way to Kuwait and have since expanded to 17 countries in the Middle East and West Africa. Of the 30.8 million eggs produced every day in Namakkal zone, around 1-3 million eggs per day are now exported to Middle East countries.

8.2 RAW GRANITE:

The Black Granite (Dolerite) is a ferromagnesian mineral bearing rock, due to the presence of high specific gravity mineral in the rock type it has heavy weight and dark color. The Multicolored Granite rocks are mainly available in Paramathi-Velur, Kabilarmalai areas. It is a light colored, less weight rock (when compare to Black Granite) 6 leases were granted to extract color Granite. In this District, out of 6 leases, two leases are mainly functioning at present.

Granite has considerable demand in the world market in the shape of rough cut slab, bush hammered and scorched slabs, paving tiles, wall paneling stair threads, bathroom/kitchen units tops.

8.3 Cotton Fabrics and Yarn

More number of power looms are concentrated in the district. Large no of power loom and handloom industries were functioning in Namakkal district. A number of power looms are located around Pallipalayam and Komarapalyam. Major variety being produced dhoti, lungi and grey material. There are enormous potential for the export of cotton fabric and yarn from the district.

8.4 Rigs

Trucks, trailers, tankers and rig units are sent here from all over the country to have their bodies built. And trucks and rig units built here are exported to other countries as well.

9.4 THREATS:

- The quantum of risk higher in foreign trade than that in international business.
- In foreign trade, goods are transported from quite a long distance and usually through seaways. The major problem of exporters is custom duty for non-exporting of eggs.
- Indian exporters face three-faced competition, while exporting. This includes competition from domestic exporters, local producers where the goods are being exported and finally from the producers of competing countries at global level. Such competition is one special problem for the exporters.
