

DISTRICT PROFILE – TIRUPPUR


PREAMBLE:

Tiruppur was formed as new district on 22.02.2009, confining the Kangayam, Vellakovil, Dharapuram, Kundadam, Mulanur, Uthukuli blocks of Erode district and Avinashi, Tiruppur, Palladam, Pongalur, Udumalpet, Madathukulam, and Gudimangalam blocks of Coimbatore district contributing to the formation of 32nd District of Tamilnadu.

Consequent to the formation of separate district for Tiruppur, the District Industries Centre started functioning at Tiruppur from 17.04.2010. Tiruppur is an important Trade Centre of India which is famous for Knitted Garments wears and is a major source of foreign exchange for the country because of its exports.

Total cultivation area in Tiruppur District is arrived approximately as 2,00,360 Hectors. Depending upon the rainfall and assured irrigation the total cultivable area may cover 100 to 150% total area. Horticulture:

Horticulture is one of the forest growing sector within Agriculture and contribute one fifth share of the total production. There has been a perceptible change in the consumption pattern characterized by declining share of food grains and the increasing share of fruits and vegetables, Rapidly growing demand for horticulture commodities and products especially burgeoning market for processed fruits and vegetables as well as booming medical plant cultivation is an evidence of phenomenon that is expected to accelerate horticulture growth. The major horticulture products cultivated in the districts are fruits (mango, amla etc.,)

In Tiruppur District flowers such as Jasmine, Loose flowers, Crossandra, Medicinal plants (Gloziosa) are cultivated in areas of Palladam, Avinashi, Pongalur & Dharapuram.,

- Apart from the above, Coir and value added Coir products (Coir fibre, Coir yarn, Curled coir, Coir pith, Geo textiles, Growbags etc) are predominant in Udumalpettaluk.
- The Subsidy linked credit Schemes implemented by the Government such as UYEGP, PMEGP and NEEDS and other subsidy incentive schemes implemented by DIC will help the District to achieve the vision of turn over of Rs 1 lakhCrore by 2024.
- India has already been relegated to the sixth rank in the global readymade garment manufacturing exports with a global market share of 3.9 per cent while Bangladesh and Vietnam are enjoying second and third positions with the market share of 7.9 per cent and 5.2 per cent respectively
- India has been competing with tariff advantaged nations like Bangladesh, Vietnam, Cambodia, Ethiopia, Myanmar and Sri Lanka in the global apparel trade. Due to intense competition in

the world textile trade, manufacturers in India are operating in wafer-thin margins

- The dyeing units that operate in Tirupur are following ZLD norms and have to spend 20-25 paise per liter of water for t .. Around 400 dyeing units are functioning in Tirupur city 18 common effluent treatment plants (CETPs) and about 100 individual effluent treatment plants (IETPs) catering to the he need of the dyeing units to comply with ZLD norms
- The textile business, already reeling under severe loss post demonetisation and implementation of GST was further been affected due to the recent economic recession, hike in the price of rawmaterial and covid lockdown.
