ORDER:

The Government in the order first read above approved the scheme "Unemployed Youth Employment Generation Programme". The scheme aims to mitigate the unemployment problems of socially and economically weaker sections of the society, particularly among the educated and unemployed to become self employed by setting up Manufacturing / Service / Business enterprises by availing loan upto the maximum of Rs.5 lakhs, Rs. 3 lakhs and Rs.1 lakh respectively with subsidy assistance from the State Government upto 15% of the project cost. The Scheme envisaged to target 10,000 beneficiaries annually.

In the Government Order second cited the Government sanctioned a sum of Rs.17.00 crores towards subsidy component to the tune of Rs.15.00 Crores and also a sum of Rs.2.00 Crores to meet expenditure towards institutional fee for conducting Entrepreneur Development Programme training to the beneficiaries, stipend to the beneficiaries and other contingent expenditure.

2. Based on the request of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce, the Government in the letter third read above, issued orders revising the physical target under the scheme for the year 2011-12 from 10,000 to 6760.

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3. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in his letter fourth read above has requested the Government to issue necessary orders with respect to the Unemployed Youth Employment Generation Programme for the year 2012-13 taking the following points into account.

- a) Revising the physical target to 5000 beneficiaries.
- b) Increase institutional training fee, Stipend and Contingency per beneficiary as Rs.1250/- Rs.750/- and Rs.500/- respectively.
- c) Provision of engaging data entry operators, expenditure on conducting review meeting at District and State Level and purchase of equipments and accessories required to process Unemployed Youth Employment Generation Programme data under Contingency fund.
- d) Revision of fund towards expenditure for conducting the District Level Workshop, Block Level Workshop and expenditure towards Printing and Publicity to Rs.60,000/- Rs.10,000/- and Rs.30,000/- respectively.

4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce fixed the expenditure in respect of items indicated in the annexure for the year 2012-13 giving 20% growth against over and above the amount sanctioned for the year 2011-12.

5. The Government also direct that given the post drop out trainees, the number of persons trained shall be kept at 25% higher than the beneficiaries assisted with subsidy.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 40159/Ind./2012, dated 16.08.2012.
